Common surgical dressings used in wound care include collagen, foam, hydrogel, and gauze. There are other options as well. Wound care providers can choose to purchase these dressings, dispense them when medically necessary, and submit coding for these products to third party payers. There are many advantages associated with participating in this program.
